After graduating from the Faculty of Library Science at the University of Toronto, he spent a few years in Thunder Bay teaching at high schools, and one year as an assistant professor at Lakehead University. In 1973, he moved to Ottawa where he entered the federal public service and served held numerous positions. He retired in March 1997. Mr. Scollie has written an extensive number of articles which have been published in a variety of sources, including the *Dictionary of Canadian Biography, Ontario History*, and the Thunder Bay Historical Museum Society's *Papers and Records*. He has also published a book titled, *Thunder Bay Mayors and Councillors, 1873-1945*. He is a lifetime member of the Thunder Bay Historical Museum Society.
