Biographical Sketch:

The Nurses Alumnae of the Port Arthur General Hospital was formed by graduate nurses on August 30th, 1928. Each year, graduates of the Port Arthur General Nursing School (which operated until 1967) were eligible to become members. The declared mandate of this organization, as stated in its constitution, was "to maintain the honour and standing of the [nursing] profession, and to promote unity among members".
